What is RPL?

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) gives guides, instructors and industry professionals the opportunity to gain formal recognition and confirmation of their skills and knowledge.

Why should I RPL my experience?

You don't have to go back to the classroom to re-study what you already know and practice. RPL converts existing skills into a statement of attainment or a whole qualification and provides people with the opportunity to improve their career prospects. RPL also ensures industry employers can access suitably qualified workers as part of their organisational risk management strategies and meet the requirements of the Adventure Activity Standards (AAS).

Become a Nationally Registered Outdoor Leader

RPL is also an important pathway for outdoor leaders to gain registration under the National Outdoor Leaders Registration Scheme (NOLRS) - industry's new professional registration scheme for the outdoor recreation sector.
